Parents, community members and pupils attended the formal meeting. Ms Mawanda presented the school with donations from her colleagues in Kampala, from Jane Harriet Namwebya, health and education consultant in Kampala, and from Food For Thought UK. 1.25m shillings was raised at the function (£250.)
