

Home stay and/or training on the Ann Family Organic Farm, in Uganda.



Welcome!/Kulika!

The Ann Family invites you to come and stay at Bulamu farm in Mubende, Central Uganda, between Kampala and Fort Portal. You can join in activities on the farm or just relax in the peaceful environment.

Accommodation

Come and stay at the heart of the farm in the main house. This has three bedrooms which can each comfortably

accommodate one or two people. The flush toilet and the bathroom are in the main house. In the kitchen there is a fuel efficient cooker built from clay which uses fire wood. The home has solar power, which allows electric lighting and can also be utilised for charging mobile phones or lap tops. The home also has a Television to ensure that people who stay there are kept updated all the time.



The Farm

The farm is managed by Godfrey Kisakye who specialises in Sustainable Organic Agriculture. He trained at Kayunga Agricultural Institute and worked with the Late Elijah Kyamuwendu (the former CEO of Kulika Uganda). The land at the farm is very productive and this allows us to grow vegetables, staple foods (bananas, cassava, beans, maize, sweet potatoes, Irish potatoes). Also we have fruit trees (mangos, oranges, pawpaw, jack fruit, bananas, oranges, avocados) and a new plantation of ginger at the farm. We also rear animals (cows, goats and hens). The farm practices agro-forestry by planting eucalyptus trees and a coffee plantation is also in establishment.

The late Elijah Kyamuwendu planted a malinge tree in order to provide herbal medicine. In front of the house there is a beautiful area of grass and flowers.

The farm grows food to feed the Ann Family of 13 people and 2 infants. At the same time it provides training to local young men who have dropped out of school but wish to learn more successful food growing skills. Some produce is sold in the local community at a relatively low price which assists poorer members of community.

Join in or relax!

There are many activities going on at the farm, which guests can join in. These include working in the garden, (digging, planting, harvesting, mulching, weeding, pruning); helping with the animals (grazing the cattle, feeding the goats and hens); visiting neighbouring farms and local Food For Thought primary schools, or going to local markets in the community. Learn how to prepare and cook Ugandan food; walk round the farm or simply relax and enjoy the peace and quiet.



Address

The address of Bulamu Farm is Kyamukoona Village, Bagezza Sub-county, Mubende District, Central Uganda. It is about 15 minutes drive from Mubende town, and 3 hour drive from Kampala City. Transport from the Entebbe Airport to the farm can be organised at a very reasonable rate by the Ann Family.

Price

The cost is £10 per day, including food, accommodation and activities.
