Thank you for your donations. Beatrice has trained the first group of ten families in Tororo. She says families have chosen to send their young people for the training. The training has included:

- Making a bag garden, a type of vertical grow-bag. This is kept near the house, so making it easy to water.
- Making a key hole garden. Food peelings can be added in the centre to compost.
- A simple way to trap run-off rain water, using the stems from banana plants.
- Planting banana suckers in a hole to conserve water and with compost.
- Discussion about organic growing over a meal.
