Seeds, suckers and training in sustainable agriculture

Thankyou for your donations! Before Christmas, Beatrice trained twenty families in Tororo, and Godfrey worked with ten families in Mubende. Each family received a 'Re-Starter Kit' with cassava cuttings, ten banana suckers, kale and cabbage seeds, five sacks to create bag gardens, an African hoe and a panga - and a training session in sustainable organic agriculture.

Godfrey persuaded neighbours to join in the training, which included:

- banana planting and management
- making raised beds
- making key-hole, mandala and bag gardens
- how to make liquid manure and plant tea
- digging contours for soil and rain retention
- how to make natural pesticides.
