- A stencil for creating a pattern
- Templates for other stencils, complete with meanings (not pictured)
- An attractive drawstring bag with bogolan design.
- An explanation of what each item symbolizes (not pictured)
- A guide on how to create your own mud cloth using local resources (not pictured)
